
And congratulations on making a very crucial and important decision, as you embark on building your dream project. The Outdoor Society is excited you have considered our expertise on this journey with you.

Conceptualization of the Project

The brief:


Design a garden sympathetic to the old architectural elements; transitory and complimentary to the modern addition; and functional in living spaces.
